
VAT printing is based on INDANTHRENE® dyes which are known for unsurpassed fastness properties on any kind of cellulosic and regenerated cellulose fibers. Prints with VAT dyes easily withstand natural UV light exposure, boil washing and even resist chlorine bleach to a great extent.

VAT printing is more complex compared to other direct-to-fabric printing solutions, but the achieved properties of end products are paying well for the additional steps in processing.










INKJET PRE-TREATMENT APPLICATION:

padder application followed by stenter drying



DIGITAL PRINTING:

digital printing followed by IR, or hot air drying



POST-PRINT PROCESSING:

padding, steam fixation, oxidation, washing

After printing and drying the substrate needs to undergo a padding process where a reducing agent is applied to solubilize the dye. Through a steam fixation the dye develops on the substrate and is permanently fixed by undergoing an oxidation process when retracting form the steamer.





